To power ON/OFF the remote set



- To power ON: Press Successful button until the unit beeps twice.
- If the unit is not powered on even if you press of a button, place it on the charger. Later, it will turn on automatically. Charge the unit for one day before using.
- To power ON: Press and hold _____button in the standby state until the unit beeps.

What is the standby state?


The stadnby state refers to the state in which no call is made or answered and the unit is ready for ringing.

(State in which the user does not speak over the phone and the telephone is waiting for operation.)



Answering a call with the remote set





When the remote set/base set tries to make a call while the base set/remote set is busy, the call is not made through with warning tone (beep-beep-beep) Try after the other unit finishes the call.

Setting the Date and Time (current date and time)

- If you set the current date and time, you can check the time when messages are recorded on the auto answering machine and activate the morning call.
- In case of power failure, the date and time is cleared. So, set the date and time again.









Making Extension Calls

• You can make a call between the handset or speakerphone of the base set and the remote set even when the line is not busy.

At this time, the call is not charged.





If there is an incoming call during an extension call, the telephone does not ring. If the separately installed telephone rings, you can answer the call after finishing the extension call

When an additional remote set is registered

You can transfer the call from a remote set to another. Press 🝙 button and then the desired remote set number.



extension call is cancelled.)

If the other party does not pick up the phone when you transfer the call, the call is returned to the originating remote set after 30 seconds. If the remote set is on the charger, however, the ringing continues for another 30 seconds and the call is automatically terminated.


When the morning call is set, the morning call icon is displayed at the bottom of the screen. The morning call rings for 2minutes.








Checking the message with the remote set (in the standby state)



• You can register up to 100 telephone numbers (to the base set) (20 to the remote set).








To store the telephone number, enter pause between the external prefix number and the telephone number.








Advanced Functions Available during Calls







These functions are set as

default when the auto

answering function is used.

Functions used for Auto Answering

- 1. Voice message record time (Time when the message is recorded by the callers)
- The time allowed for the caller to leave a message on the auto answering machine is 3 minutes.
 Correct date and time at which the message is left is announced only when the date and time is set in the unit.
- 2. Auto Answering Ring Count (Ansewring Ring Count : The number of rings before the unit switches to auto answering mode when there is an incoming call)

• The auto-answering bell count can be setup respectively for both auto-answering on and off.




• If the caller does not speak a word for 10 seconds for recording on the auto answering machine, the call is automatically terminated.




Checking the caller's voice (Caller Identification)

When the caller is leaving a message in the auto answering mode, you can hear his or her voice through the speaker.





Select "0" to make the bell ring three times for a new voice message, and 6 times for no new voice message.



You can control the telephone state by making a call to your phone from the outside. At this time, you have to know the password. At the time of purchase, the password for remote control is set to 0000. (To change the password, do as shown here.)

* If you become unable to take calls without turning on the auto answering machine, the telephone rings as many times as the set remote answering ring count (15 times as default) and then the answering message is transmitted.

To use the auto-answering function outside, the phone should be in tone dialing mode.

If the buttons are not properly entered at the time of remote control from the outside, press and shortly hold the buttons.





 Press button while dialing with the base set or the remote set, and the dialing mode is switched to the tone dialing mode.




Low Voltage Warning Function



Anything wrong with the telephone?

The telephone does not work at all.

- Make it sure that the telephone is correctly installed. (See Page 8)
- Make it sure that the adaptor is properly installed according to the specified voltage. (See Page 8)
- Make it sure that the the battery is correctly placed in the remote set. (See Page 9)
- Did you charge the remote set battery enough? (See Page9)
- Is the remote set power ON? (See Page 8)

There is no dial tone when I pressed () button.

- Make it sure that the telephone line is correctly connected. (See Page 8)
- Make it sure that the power cord is properly connected. (See Page 8)
- Check the speaker volume. (See Page 17)

Morning call does not work.



- Check if the base set is busy. Try to make a call after the base set finishes its call.
- Make it sure that the remote set isn't too far from the base set. Move closer to the base set. (See Page 11)
- ______ is displayed on the remote set LCD and the low voltage warning is displayed, finish the call immediately and then charge the remote set enough before using. (See Page 41)


