

DVD Remote Control Functions Chart



1. POWER Button

Turns the power on or off.

- 2. NUMBER Buttons
- 3. CLEAR Button

Use to remove menus or status displays from the screen.

- 4. VCR Select Button
- 5. DVD Select Button
- 6. REWIND / SKIP BACK Button
- 7. STOP Button
- 8. SUBTITLE Button
- 9. MENU Button

Brings up the DVD-Player's setup menu.

- 10. RECORD Button
- 11. PROGRESSIVE / SPEED Button
- 12. MODE / REPEAT Button
- 13. OPEN / CLOSE Button

To open and close the disc tray.

14. AUDIO Button

Use this button to access various audio functions on a disc.

- 15. INPUT SEL. / F.ADV / SKIP Button
- 16. FAST-FORWARD / SKIP NEXT Button
- 17. PLAY / PAUSE Button
 Begin / Pause disc play.
- **18. INFO. Button**Displays the current disc mode.
- **19. RETURN Button**Returns to a previous menu.
- 20. ENTER / DIRECTION Buttons (UP / DOWN or LEFT / RIGHT Buttons)


These buttons function as a toggle switch.


- 21. DISC MENU Button


Basic TV Video NTSC Connection Enhanced TV Video Connection

Basic TV Audio Left / Right Connection




