




The following illustrations represent the precautions to be taken when using and moving your television.



Do NOT expose the television to extreme temperature conditions or to extreme humidity conditions.




Do NOT expose the television to direct sunlight.




Do NOT expose the television to any liquids.

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

Using the Front Panel Controls

If the remote control no longer works or you have lost it, you can use controls on the panel of the TV to:

- lacktriangle Switch on the TV when it is in Standby mode and select channels (lacktriangle CH lacktriangle or lacktriangle CH lacktriangle).
- ◆ Access the menu (**MENU**).
- ◆ Adjust the volume (**VOL** +).
- ◆ Switch among Video input modes (**TV/VIDEO**).

How to use the CH▼/A buttons to switch among Video input modes (the model without TV/VIDEO button):





This figure shows the Standard Connector-jack panel.

1 CONNECTING EXTERNAL A/V DEVICES (INPUT)

The RCA (VIDEO + AUDIO-L and R) connectors are used for equipment such as camcorders, video disc players and some video game devices.

- ➤ When both the side (or front) and rear connectors are connected to external equipment, the side (or front) AV has the priority.
 - When using the mono equipment such as camcorders, video disc players and some video game devices, connect to the "AUDIO-L" input connector.

2 CONNECTING EXTERNAL S-VIDEO DEVICES (INPUT) (Option)

- Video and audio inputs for external devices with an S-Video output, such as a camcorder or VCR.

3 CONNECTING HEADPHONES (Option)

- You can connect a set of headphones to your television if you wish to watch a television programme without disturbing the other people in the room.
- Prolonged use of headphones at a high volume may damage your hearing.



Inserting the Batteries in the Remote Control










You must insert or replace the batteries in the remote control when you:

- ◆ Purchase the television
- Find that the remote control is no longer operating correctly
- 1 Remove the cover on the rear of the remote control by pressing the symbol (♥) downwards and then pulling firmly to remove it.
- Insert two R03, UM4, "AAA" 1.5V or equivalent batteries taking care to respect the polarities:
 - on the battery against on the remote control
 - + on the battery against + on the remote control
- 3 Replace the cover by aligning it with the base of the remote control and pressing it back into place.

Connecting to an Aerial or Cable Television Network





To view television channels correctly, a signal must be received by the set from one of the following sources:

- ♦ An outdoor aerial
- ◆ A cable television network
- ♦ A satellite network
- 1 In the first three cases, connect the aerial or network input cable to the 75Ω coaxial socket on the rear of the television.
- 2 If you are using an indoor aerial, you may need to turn it when tuning your television until you obtain a picture that is both sharp and clear.

Signal Strength($\frac{\Psi_{11}}{\| \|}$) display (Option)

The "Yall "(Signal Strength) symbol is displayed by pressing the "INFO ()" button. This symbol displays signal strength for your watching TV channel. The more signal bar is the better TV gets sensitivity on current channel.

Switching Your Television On and Off

The mains lead is attached to the rear of your television.

- 1 Plug the mains lead into an appropriate socket.
 - The main voltage is indicated on the rear of the television and the frequency is 50 or 60Hz.
- 2 Press the " () " button (On/Off) on the front of the television.


Result: The Standby indicator on the front of the television lights up.

3 Press the POWER ((()) button on the remote control to switch the television on.

Result: The programme that you were watching last is reselected automatically.

- If you have not yet stored any channels, No clear picture appears. Refer to "Storing Channels Automatically" on page 15 or "Storing Channels Manually" on page 16.
- 4 To switch your television off, press the " () " button (On/Off) again.





Placing Your Television in Standby Mode

Your television can be placed in Standby mode, in order to reduce:


- **♦** Power consumption
- ♦ Wear of the cathode ray tube


The Standby mode can be useful when you wish to interrupt viewing temporarily (during a meal, for example).


1 Press the **POWER** ((()) button on the remote control.

Result: The screen is turned off and the Standby indicator on the front of the television lights up in red.

- 2 To switch the television back on, simply press the **POWER** ((()) button again.
 - You can also switch on by pressing the **P** or button.











Becoming Familiar with the Remote Control







The remote control is used mainly to:

- ♦ Change channels and adjust the volume
- ♦ Set up the television using the on-screen menu system

Plug & Play Feature (depending on the model)

When the television is initially powered on, three basic customer settings proceed automatically and subsequently: setting the language, channel and clock.

1 If the television is in Standby mode, press the **POWER** (③) button on the remote control.

Result: The message Plug & Play is displayed. It flickers for a little while and then Language menu is automatically displayed.

2 Select the appropriate language by pressing the ▼ or ▲ button. Press the ENTER (→) button to enter the language.

Result: The message Check antenna input. is displayed.

If any language is not selected on the Language menu, the Language menu will disappear about 30 seconds later.

Make sure that the antenna is connected to the TV. Press the ENTER () button.

Result: The Auto Store menu is displayed with Area is selected.

4 Press the ENTER (→) button again. Select your area by pressing the ▼ or ▲ button, and then Press the ENTER (→) button.

To search the channels, select Search by pressing the ▼ or ▲ button, and then press the ENTER (→) button.

Press the ENTER (→) button again to start search the channels.

Press the MENU (□) button to stop the search.

Result: The Time menu is displayed with Clock is selected.

- Fress the ◀ or ▶ button to move to the hour or minute. Set the hour or minute by pressing the ▼ or ▲ button.
 - Refer to "Setting and Displaying the Current Time" on page 30.
- 6 When you have finished, press the MENU (Ⅲ) button.







Viewing the Demonstration







To become familiar with the various menus provided by your television, you can view the in built demonstration.

1 Press the **MENU** (____) button.

Result: The main menu is displayed.

2 Press the ▼ or ▲ button to select Setup.

Result: The options available in the Setup group are displayed.

3 Press the ENTER (→) button.

4 Press the ▼ or ▲ button to select Demonstration.

5 Press the **ENTER** () button.

Result: Each of the menu options is displayed in turn.

When you wish to exit from the demonstration, press the EXIT (→□) button on the remote control.

Choosing Your Language



When you start using your television for the first time, you must select the language which will be used for displaying menus and indications.

1 Press the MENU (III) button.

Result: The main menu is displayed.

2 Press the ▼ or ▲ button to select Setup.

Result: The options available in the Setup group are displayed.

3 Press the ENTER (→) button.

4 Press the ▼ or ▲ button to select Language.

Select the appropriate language by pressing the ENTER () button repeatedly.

Storing Channels Automatically

You can scan for the frequency ranges available to you (and availability depends on your country). Automatically allocated programme numbers may not correspond to actual or desired programme numbers. However you can sort numbers manually and clear any channels you do not wish to watch.

1 Press the MENU (III) button.

Result: The main menu is displayed.

2 Press the ▼ or ▲ button to select Channel.

Result: The options available in the Channel group are displayed.

3 Press the ENTER (←) button.

Result: The Auto Store is selected.

4 Press the ENTER (→) button again.

Result: The options available in the Auto Store group are displayed with Area is selected.

- 5 Press the **ENTER** () button again.
- 6 Select your area by pressing the ▼ or ▲ button, then press the ENTER (→) button.

The areas are displayed in the following order:



The horizontal bar is displayed, and then channels are stored in an order which reflects their positions in the frequency range. Finally, the search will end automatically.


- To stop the search before it has finished, press the **MENU** (III) button.
- When searching and storing are complete, the Sort menu is displayed.
 - To sort the stored channels into the desired numerical order, go to Step 6 of the "Sorting the Stored Channels" procedure on page 19
 - To exit from the channel store function without sorting the channels, press the MENU ([]]) button repeatedly until the menus disappear.
- 10 When the channels have been stored, you can:
 - Sort them in the order required (refer to page 19)
 - ◆ Clear a channel (refer to page 18)
 - ◆ Activate the Digital Noise Reduction feature (refer to page 23)
















Storing the Channels Automatically - Turbo Store






Using Turbo search you can store all the channels found in your country in much less time compared to auto store.


The channels are stored in the order in which they appear in the frequency bands. It is possible that the automatically allocated numbers may not correspond to those by which you wish to identify the channels. If this is the case, refer to "Sorting the Stored Channels" on page 16.

 Perform the above mentioned steps to store channels using Turbo Store. In the third step select Turbo store instead of Auto store.

Storing Channels Manually









You can store the channels, including those received via cable networks.

When storing channels manually, you can choose:

- ♦ Whether or not to store each of the channels found
- ◆ The programme number of each stored channel which you wish to identify

- 2 Press the ▼ or ▲ button to select Channel.
- 3 Press the ENTER (→) button.

- To assign a programme number to a channel, press the ◀or ▶ button.



 - If no sound or abnormal sound, re-select the sound standard required.




- P (Programme mode): When completing tuning, the broadcasting stations in your area have been assigned to position numbers from P00 to max P199. You can select a channel by entering the position number in this mode.
- ◆ C (Real channel mode): You can select a channel by entering the assigned number to each air broadcasting station in this mode
- \$ (Cable channel mode): You can select a channel by entering the assigned number for each cable channel in this mode.













Skipping Unwanted Channels









You can exclude the channels you chosen from the channels you scanned. When you scan through the stored channels, those you have chosen to skip are not displayed.

All of the channels that you do not specifically choose to skip are displayed during scanning.

1 Press the MENU (III) button.

Result: The main menu is displayed.

2 Press the ▼ or ▲ button to select Channel.

Result: The options available in the Channel group are displayed.

3 Press the ENTER () button.

4 Press the ▼ or ▲ button to select Add/Delete.
