Before operating the unit, please read this manual thoroughly, and retain it for future reference.

Safety Instructions

- Do not expose the television to extreme temperature conditions or to extreme humidity conditions.
- Do not expose the television to direct sunlight and other sources of heat.
- Do not expose the television to any liquids.
- Never put objects of any kind into the television, and do not place a water-containing vessel on the television.
- During a storm conditions (especially when there is lightning) unplug the television from the mains socket and aerial.
- Do not step on or twist the power cord.
- Do not overload wall outlets or extension cords as this can result in a risk of fire or electric shock.
- Please use a soft and dry cloth (not containing volatile matter) when you clean the TV.
- If the television is broken, do not try to repair it yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.
- If the remote control is not used for a long period of time, remove the batteries and store it in a cool, dry place.
- Do not drop the remote control.

This device is not for use in industrial environments.

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

Using the Buttons on the Front Panel

If your remote control no longer works or you have lost it, you can use the controls on the front panel of the television to:

- Switch on the television when it is in Standby mode and select channels (▼ CH ▲)
- ◆ Access the main menu (MENU)
- ◆ Adjust the volume (VOL +)

Buttons on the front panel have the same function as corresponding buttons on the remote control.

The actual configuration on your TV may be different, depending on your model.


Front (or Side) of TV



\succ Connecting earphones (\mathfrak{D}) /headphones (\square)


- You can connect a set of earphones/headphones to your television if you wish to watch a television programme without disturbing the other people in the room.






Infrared Remote Control (Teletext Functions)

Inserting the Batteries in the Remote Control








You must insert or replace the batteries in the remote control when you :

- Purchase the television.
- Find that the remote control is no longer operating correctly.
- **1** Remove the cover of the remote control by pressing the symbol $(\overline{\clubsuit})$ and pulling the cover in the direction of the arrow.
- 2 Insert batteries, taking care to respect the polarities:
 - + on the battery with + on the remote control
 - ♦ on the battery with on the remote control
- **3** Replace the cover by pushing it in the direction of the arrow.

Connecting the Aerial or Cable Television Network



To view television channels correctly, a signal must be received by the set from one of the following sources:

- ♦ An outdoor aerial
- A cable television network
- A satellite network

Plug the aerial or cable network input cable to the 75Ω coaxial socket on the rear of the television.

Switching Your Television On and Off


The mains lead is attached to the rear of the television.

- **1** Plug the mains lead into an appropriate socket.
 - The main voltage is indicated on the rear of the TV set and the frequency is 50 or 60Hz.
- Press the "①" (ON/OFF) button on the front of the television.

 <u>Result</u>:
 The Standby indicator lights up on the front panel.
- **3** Press the **POWER** ((()) button on the remote control to switch the television on.

<u>Result</u>: The programme that you were watching last is reselected automatically.

4 To switch your television off, press the "①" (ON/OFF) button again on the front of the television.



Placing Your Television in Standby mode

Your television can be placed in Standby mode, in order to reduce:

- Power consumption
- Wear of the cathode ray tube

The Standby mode can be useful when you wish to interrupt viewing temporarily (during a meal, for example).

The television is placed automatically in Standby mode when you turn it on.


 Image: Press the POWER (@) button on the remote control.

 Result:
 The screen is turned off and the Standby indicator on the front of the television lights up.


2 To switch the screen back on, simply press the **POWER** ((()) button again on the remote control.

> You can also switch on by pressing the \mathbf{P} or \bigcirc button.

Do not leave your television in standby mode for long periods of time (when you are away on holiday, for example). In this case, you should switch it off completely.




Choosing Your Language


When you start using your television for the first time, you must select the language which will be used for displaying menus and indications.

1	Press the MENU (IIII) button.
2	Press the \blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown button to select the Function.
3	Press the ◀ or ► button to select the Language.
4	Select a particular language by pressing the ◀ or ► button repeatedly.
5	When you have finished, press the EXIT (-I) button or, press the

MENU (Ⅲ) button repeatedly to return to normal viewing.

When using the numeric buttons to select a channel stored at programme position ten or higher, follow the instructions below.

You can scan the frequency ranges available on your television and in your country and store all the channels found automatically.

The channels are stored in the order in which they appear in the frequency bands. It is possible that the automatically allocated numbers may not correspond to those by which you wish to identify the channels. If this is the case, refer to "Sorting the Stored Channels" on page 16.

Storing the Channels Manually

When storing channels manually, you can choose:

- Whether or not to store each of the channels found.
- The number by which you wish to identify each stored channel.
- 1 Press the **MENU** (IIII) button.
- Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the Channel and press the ◄ or ▶ button.
- 3 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the Manual Store and press the ◀ or ► button.

<u>Result:</u> The Manual Store menu is displayed with the Color System selected.

- 4 Press the ◄ or ► button repeatedly until the color is of the best quality.
 - <u>Result:</u> The **color System** is changed (depending on the model).

- NTSC4.43 is a "trick" playback mode used by special VCR's to play PAL-recorded videos in NTSC mode.
- 5 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the sound system and press the ◀ or ► button repeatedly until the sound is of the best quality.
 - <u>Result:</u> The **Sound System** is changed (depending on the model).

If sound does not work regularly after storing channels, select the sound system which best corresponds.

- 6 To start the search, select the search and then press the ◄ or ► button.
 - Result: The tuner scans the frequency range until the first channel or the channel that you selected is received on your screen.
- 7 To assign a programme number to the channel, select the **Prog.No.**. Press the ◀ or ► button until you find the correct number.
- 8 To store the channel and associated programme number, select the **store** and press the **◄** or **▶** button.

Result: **ok** is displayed.

- 9 Repeat Steps 6 to 8 for each channel to be stored.
- 10 When you have finished manual storage, press the EXIT (→□) button or, press the MENU (□□) button repeatedly to return to normal viewing

You can exclude the channels of your choice from the channel scan operation. When you scan through the stored channels, those you have chosen to skip are not displayed.

All channels that you do not specifically choose to skip are displayed during scanning.

- **1** Press the **MENU** (IIII) button.
- Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the Channel and press the ◄ or ▶ button.
- 3 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the Add/Erase and press the ◄ or ► button.
 - <u>Result:</u> The Add/Erase menu is displayed.
- 4 Press the \blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown button to select the required channel.
- **5** To add or erase the desired channel by pressing the \triangleleft or \triangleright button.
- 6 When you have finished adding and erasing channels, press the EXIT (→□) button or, press the MENU (□□) button repeatedly to return to normal viewing

Fine tuning Channel Reception

If the reception is clear, you do not have to fine-tune the channel, as this is done automatically during the search and store operation. If however the signal is weak or distorted, you may have to finetune the channel manually.



- Modify the numeric order in which the channels have been automatically stored.
- Give easily remembered numbers to the channels that you watch most often.

 Press the ◄ or ► button.

Result: The Mode menu is selected.



- The television has an "automatic degaussing" system that is activated if magnetic interference is present. To degauss the television screen, switch power off by pressing the "①" (ON/OFF) button on the front panel (refer to "Automatic Degaussing to Remove Color Patches" on page 34).
- If you make any changes to the Adjust settings, the picture standard is automatically switched to Custom.

Changing the Sound Standard (depending on the model)

You can select the type of special sound effect to be used when watching a given broadcast. The following sound effects are available in the order given:

- Custom, Standard, Music, Movie, Speech.
- 1 Press the MENU (IIII) button.
- 2 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the **sound** and press the ◀ or ► button.

Result: The Mode menu is selected.

- **3** Select to satisfy your preference by pressing the **◄** or **▶** button.
- 4 When you have been finished, press the **EXIT** (→**□**) button or, press the **MENU** (□□) button repeatedly to return to normal viewing.
- You can select the required sound effect by simply pressing the "S.MODE" (Sound Mode) button on the remote control.

Adjusting the Volume (depending on the model)



You can adjust the volume by pressing the \bigcirc or \bigcirc button on the remote control.

- Press the button to increase the volume (cursor moves to the right)
- Press the
 button to decrease the volume (cursor moves to the left)

The volume setting is retained:

- When you switch the television to standby mode
- When you switch the television off using the "①" (ON/OFF) button on the front panel
- If there is a power failure.

Extra Sound Settings (depending on the model)

The following sound settings can be adjusted to suit your personal preferences.

Auto Volume

Each broadcasting station has its own signal conditions, and so it is not easy for you to adjust the volume every time the channel is changed. **Auto Volume** lets you automatically adjust the volume of the desired channel by lowering the sound output when the modulation signal is high or by raising the sound output when the modulation signal is low.

Melody

You can hear clear melody sound when the TV is powered ON or OFF.

Pseudo Stereo

Pseudo Stereo converts a monaural sound signal into two identical left and right channels. Once the **Pseudo Stereo** is set to **On** or **Off**, the setting

applies to the sound effects such as **Standard**, **Music**, **Movie** and **Speech**.

Turbo Sound

You can enjoy more magnificent and dynamic sound when watching music, movie or other channel. **Turbo Sound** suitably emphasizes both higher and lower bands of sound (and includes other effects).

1 Press the MENU (TTT) button.
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2 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the **sound** and press the ◀ or ► button.



You can select the turbo sound by simply pressing the "TURBO" button on the remote control.











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The "DUAL I-II" button displays/controls the processing and output of the audio signal. When power is switched ON, the mode is automatically preset to either "Dual-I" or "STEREO", depending on the current transmission.

 If the receiving conditions deteriorate, listening will be easier if the mode is set to the MONO position using the DUAL I-II button.

- If the stereo signal is weak (or if intermittent Stereo-Mono) and automatic switching occurs, then switch to the **MONO** mode.
- When receiving mono sound in the AV mode, connect to the "L" input jack on the panels. If the mono sound comes out only from the left speaker, then press the DUAL I-II button.

Switching the Sound Off Temporarily

You can switch the sound off temporarily, for example you may wish to answer the telephone.

 Press the MUTE (𝕵) button.




Setting the Sleep Timer (depending on the model)

You can select a time period of between 30 and 180 minutes after which the television automatically switches to Standby mode by pressing the "SLEEP (O)" button.

Switching the Television On and Off Automatically (depending on the model)

You can set the On/Off timers so that the television will:

- Switch on automatically and tune to the channel of your choice at the time you select
- Switch off automatically at the time you select
- The first step is to set the television's clock (refer to Setting and Displaying the Current Time on the previous page). If you have not yet set the clock, the message Set the clock first is displayed.
- 1 Press the MENU (IIII) button.
- Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the Function and press the ◄ or ▶ button.
- 3 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the **Time**, and press the ◀ or ► button.

Result: The Time menu is displayed.

- 4 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the **Timer**.
- **5** Press the \triangleleft or \blacktriangleright button to set the mode to **on**.

<u>Result</u>: The **On Time** and **Off Time** options are displayed.

- 6 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the **On Time**.
- 7 Set the time at which you wish the television to be switched On.


When you set the timer "On", your television will eventually be turned off, if you do not operate any controls during the 3 hours after the TV is turned on by timer. This function is available in only the timer "On" mode and will prevent a leakage accident or overheating, caused by your TV left on for a long time due to the timer "On" (when you are away on holiday, for example).












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You can restrict viewing by locking the channels of your choice. <u>Example</u>: You can prevent your children from watching unsuitable programmes.

- **1** Press the **MENU** (IIII) button.
- Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the Function and press the ◄ or ▶ button.
- 3 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the child Lock and press the ◄ or ► button.

Result: The Child Lock menu is displayed.

- 4 Set to **on** by pressing the \triangleleft or \triangleright button.
 - If you want to unlock a channel, set to Off.
- 5 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the Prog.No.. Select the number of the channel to be locked by pressing the ◄ or ► button.
- 6 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the Lock and press the ◄ or ► button.
 - Result: Locked is displayed.

- When you have finished, press the **EXIT** (**→I)** button or, press the **MENU** (**III**) button repeatedly to return to normal viewing.
- If any channel is locked, you can not enter the Channel menu by using the control buttons on the television, and the message "Not available" is displayed. You can access by using the remote control only.

Setting the Blue Screen Mode

If no signal is being received or the signal is very weak, a blue screen automatically replaces the noisy picture background.

If you wish to continue viewing the poor picture, you must set the "Blue Screen" mode to "Off".





You can enjoy the game (Chicken Farm), programmed in this TV.


- **1** Press the **GAME** button to enter the Game mode.
 - <u>Result:</u> The **READY** window will be displayed.
- 2 Press the \triangleleft or \triangleright button to run the game.
- 3 Move the farmer to catch eggs by using the ◀ or ► button. Every time the scores go up, the speed of game becomes faster bit by bit.
- 4 Every time you catch fifty eggs (i.e., 50, 100, 150 ...), if any broken egg exists, one egg can be restored. When five eggs are lost, the game will be over and simultaneously the final score window will be displayed.
- 5 If you want to stop during the game, press the **MENU** (**III**) button. Then, the final score window will be displayed.
- 6 If you want to re-start the game, press the **MENU** (Ⅲ), ◀ or ► button. Then, the final score window will be switched to the **READY** window.



You can display teletext information at any time, but signal reception must be good. Otherwise:



To activate the teletext mode and display the contents page:

- 1 Using the ⊘(𝔅) or ⊘(𝔅) button, select the channel providing the teletext service.
- 2 Press the TTX/MIX (I) button to activate the teletext mode.
 - Result: The contents page (page 100) is displayed. It can be redisplayed at any time by pressing the (index) button.
- **3** To display the actual broadcast simultaneously with the teletext page, press the **TTX/MIX** (**E**|**)** button.
- 4 To return to normal viewing press the **TV** (
) button.



Selecting a Specific Teletext Page (depending on the model)



Press the number buttons on the remote control to enter the page number directly:

- **1** Enter the three-digit page number listed in the contents by pressing the corresponding numeric buttons.


Using FLOF to Select a Teletext Page (depending on the model)

The various topics included in the teletext pages are color-coded, and can be selected by pressing the colored buttons on the remote control.







Connecting to the Audio/Video Input/Outputs

The actual configuration on your TV may be different, depending on your model.



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Automatic Degaussing to Remove Color Patches

A degaussing coil is mounted around the picture tube, so you do not normally need to degauss the television manually.

If you move the television to a different position and color patches appear on the screen, you must:

- Switch the television off by pressing the " ① " (ON/OFF) button on the front panel
- Unplug the television from the wall socket
- ◆ Leave the television power-off (stand-by) for about 30 minutes so that the automatic degauss function can be activated, and then press the POWER (◎) button on the remote control.

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If your television will be left unattended, press the " \bigcirc " (ON/OFF) button to turn your television off.

Troubleshooting: Before Contacting Service Personnel

Before contacting Samsung after-sales service, perform the following simple checks.

If you cannot solve the problem using the instructions below, note the model and serial number of the television and contact your local dealer.

No sound or picture	 Check that the mains lead has been connected to a wall socket. Check that you have pressed the "①" (ON/OFF) button. Check the picture contrast and brightness settings. Check the volume.
Normal picture but no sound	 ♦ Check the volume. ♦ Check whether the MUTE (๓¾) button has been pressed on the remote control.
No picture or black and white picture	 Adjust the colour settings. Check that the broadcast system selected is correct.
Sound and picture interference	 Try to identify the electrical appliance that is affecting the television and move it further away. Plug your television into a different mains socket.
Blurred or snowy picture, distorted sound	 Check the direction, location and connections of your aerial. This interference is often due to the use of an indoor aerial.
Remote control malfunctions	 Replace the remote control batteries. Clean the upper edge of the remote control (transmission window). Check the battery terminals.
